## **Community Foundation of San Joaquin Announces Grant Funding Availability to Support Healthcare Services, Medical Education**

*Stockton* – The Community Foundation of San Joaquin (CFOSJ) announced today the availability of grant funding from its Community Health Fund. Eligible nonprofit organizations and local public agencies are invited to submit letters of interest for grant funding to support projects and activities that serve people living in San Joaquin or Calaveras County, and directly align with the Community Health Fund's areas of interest: *improving healthcare services, health outcomes, and supporting medical education.*

CFOSJ has committed a total of \$200,000 for this grants program in 2017. The maximum grant amount an applicant may request under this program is \$50,000, although applicants may request less than the maximum amount.
